

Proposals for The Holden Gallery's Exhibitions' Programme

The Holden Gallery has a fully curated exhibitions programme that focuses exclusively on recent developments in international contemporary visual art. Unlike many other galleries of its kind however, it continues to receive exhibition proposals for consideration from contemporary artists and curators across the world.

Proposals should include the following documentation:

- A written outline of the proposed exhibition.
- Images of contemporary artworks to be included or synopsis of newly commissioned work to be made.
- A biography and CV for each artist and curator included in the project.
- An outline of the budget and income already received/generated.
- Return postal address for physical documentation.

Once received, proposals will be considered by The Holden Gallery's exhibitions group, which meets on a quarterly basis, in January, April, July and October.

Applicants will be made aware of the decision by the group by email or post after each quarterly meeting.
