Manchester Metropolitan University will hold and process applicant data in accordance with the relevant Data Protection legislation, including but not limited to the Data Protection Act 2018 and the General Data Protection Regulation (see the Privacy Notice below for further information).

Privacy notice for Holden Gallery Graduate Awards

This Privacy Notice explains who we are, how and why we collect and use personal information about you, what personal data is collected and held about you for the Holden Gallery Graduate Award, our purposes and lawful bases for processing, who we share your personal data with, relevant retention periods, and how you can exercise your privacy rights.

Who we are

Throughout this notice, “University”, “we”, “our” and “us” refer to the Manchester Metropolitan University, an exempt charity under Schedule 2 to the Charities Act 1993 (amended by the Charities Act 2011). The University is the Data Controller in respect of the personal data you provide as part of your application to the Holden Gallery Graduate Awards.

The University is registered as a Controller with the Information Commissioner’s Office (ICO). We manage personal data in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the University’s Data Protection Policy.

The personal data we process

We collect and process certain data about you. This includes:

- Your first and last name
- The programme you studied on
- The year you graduated
- Your email address

The purposes of processing

To assess applications to the Holden Gallery Graduate Awards and select appropriate candidates.

The Award organiser Zoe Watson will forward applications to the selection panel who are Manchester Metropolitan University staff to proceed with selection process. The successful candidates’ applications will be shared with the award mentors.

Our lawful basis for processing your personal data under article 6 of GDPR is Legitimate Interests.

Data retention

Your personal data will only be retained for as long as it is necessary in accordance with the **University's Retention and Disposal Schedule**.

In relation to the personal data we hold for the purposes of informing other universities of your application, we will retain your personal data until the fellowship is awarded.

If your application is unsuccessful, we will retain your personal data for a period of 1 year from completion of the selection process.

Your rights in respect of the processing

The GDPR provides data subjects with the following data subject rights:

- The right to be informed – this privacy notice assists with fulfilling these obligations.
- The right of access.
- The right to rectification.
- The right to erasure.
- The right to restrict processing
- The right to data portability
- The right to object

Please note, that these rights apply in certain circumstances, for example according to the lawful basis utilised by the University.
